As you know a state of emergency has been declared as a result of the novel Coronavirus pandemic which is presently spreading around the world. As of now, medical professionals recommend that everyone practices social isolation, washes their hands frequently, and avoids touching their face, mouth, nose, eyes, and ears if their hands have not been recently washed. Using a hand sanitizer that has at least 60% alcohol, wiping off frequently used items such as doorknobs, toilets, etc. with a disinfecting alcohol wipe, and avoiding gatherings larger than 25 people are also recommended. Further, stay away from people who are sniffing or coughing, and try to keep a distance of 6-9 feet from other people if possible. We also recommend everyone to begin taking their temperature at least twice a day in precaution. If you have a high temperature, or if you're sick, you should contact your primary doctor for advice before you present to your doctor's office.

If you have a life-threatening emergency, you should call 911. If you do not have medical insurance, you should contact a local emergency room by telephone and ask them what you should do. It is also possible to pay for doctors' consultations online if you do not have a primary physician or medical insurance by searching for 'online medical consultations'. If you, someone you live with, or a coworker has a high temperature, contact a doctor for advice. Anyone experiencing symptoms should also stop going into work/public places until cleared by a medical professional.

Above all, avoid going into public unless necessary and avoid contact with anyone displaying symptoms, as you risk infecting yourself as well as others.
